The art is truly outstanding, gripping the heart from the very first spread and not letting go. With colored shapes and stained-glass motifs, these Black figures feel real and weighty. Within this deep dive are tragedy, fear, anger, and mourning alongside hope, comfort, strength, and triumph. This slim book contains a necessary and healing exploration of our current moment that will remain relevant for decades to come.

Whimsy, intelligence, and a subtle narrative thread make this rise to the top of a growing list of self-love titles. Employing a cast of diverse children reminiscent of that depicted in *Another*, Robinson shows that every living entity has value.

After opening endpapers that depict an aerial view of a busy playground, the perspective shifts to a black child, ponytails tied with beaded elastics, peering into a microscope. So begins an exercise in perspective. Periodically, the examples are validated with the titular refrain. Textured paint strokes and collage elements contrast with uncluttered backgrounds that move from white to black to white. The black pages in the middle portion foreground scenes in space, including a black astronaut viewing Earth; the astronaut is holding an image of another black youngster who appears on the next spread flying a toy rocket and looking lonely. There are many such visual connections, creating emotional interest and invitations for conversation.

The book makes a subtle but important point about diversity by depicting the kids' brown-skinned grandmother as "Blue-eyed.

The next spread reveals the girl, shocked and possibly horrified, as she meets an arachnid with "Six-eyes?"

The romantic notions of carriage rides are silhouetted in the background of an ordinary and busy day at the park. If there are mishaps within the book, they are natural mishaps of the animals in the park a dog splashes in a water fountain disrupting a frog. It was a small detail I noted that a park can be as active as it can be calming. Anne Marie inventories the activity without overwhelming young readers with the shorter lines and the rhyme scheme. Pulling the verse away from the visual, Anne Marie offers a mentor text in List Poetry and what it can sound and feel like for the writer and the reader. Anne Marie's use of "eye" throughout the book might invite the writer's "I. Or the "L-I-ving Room" wherein one might list the things they might see in a living area.

Their busy eyes see all the fun things surrounding them. I love the illustrations. They are colorful and eye-catching, and they show great diversity. They seem to capture the text as well as could possibly be expected. Unfortunately, the text itself is awkward in many places from trying so hard to rhyme and to keep with the "busy-eyed" theme.
